Constitution of Sowerby Bridge Snails Running Club

1) **Name**.

The name of the Group shall be called the Sowerby Bridge Snails Running Club or Sowerby Bridge Snails R.C.

2) Aims

The Aim of the Group shall be to establish a running club in Sowerby Bridge and the surrounding areas that:

- i. Encourages beginners to take up running
- ii. Encourages community spirit
- iii. Helps local projects by fundraising
- iv. Occasionally competes and organizes running events
- v. Generally helps the wellbeing of the local community in any way it can

3) Management.

- a) The Group shall be administered by a Management Committee of not less than three and not more than 15 individuals elected at the Group's Annual General Meeting (A.G.M.).
- b) The Officers of the Management Committee and those forming the 'executive committee' shall be: the Chairperson, the Treasurer and the Secretary.
- c) The Management Committee may co-opt onto the Committee, up to three individuals, in an advisory and non-voting capacity that it feels will help to fulfill the aim of the Group.
- d) The Management Committee shall meet at least once every month.
- e) At least three Management Committee members must be present for a Management Committee meeting to take place.
- f) Voting at Management Committee meetings shall be by a show of hands. If there is a tied vote then the Chairperson shall have a second vote.
- g) The Management Committee shall have the power to remove any member of the Committee for good and proper reason with the exception of the chairperson.
- h) The Management Committee may appoint any other member of the Group as a Committee member to fill a vacancy, provided that the maximum prescribed is not exceeded.
- i) The chairperson, treasurer and secretary (being the executive committee) have the power to veto and vote (by unanimous decision only) and have final say in all matters attaining to the club.
- j) The chairperson and founder Jodie Smith may not be removed from their position except for by resignation.

4) Membership

- a) Membership will be open to anybody without regards to disability, political or religious affiliation, race, sex or sexual orientation who is:
- Interested in helping the Group to achieve its aim
- Will abide by the rules of the Group
- Will pay any subscription agreed by the Management Committee.

b) The membership of any member may be terminated for good reason by the Management Committee: Provided that the member concerned shall have the right to be heard by the Management Committee, accompanied by a friend, before a final decision is made.

5) Powers

In order to achieve its aim the Group may:

- a) Raise money
- b) Apply for grants
- c) Open bank accounts
- d) Acquire and run buildings
- e) Take out insurance
- f) Employ staff
- g) Organise courses and events
- h) Work with similar Groups and exchange information and advice with them
- i) Do anything that is lawful which will help it to fulfill its aim.

6) The Duties of the Officers.

a) The duties of the Chairperson shall be to:

- Chair meetings of the Committee and the Group
- represent the Group at functions/meetings that the Group has been invited to and
- act as the spokesperson of the Group when necessary.

b) The duties of the Secretary shall be to:

- prepare in consultation with the Chairperson the agenda for meetings of the Committee and the Group
- take and keep records of all meetings and
- collect and circulate any relevant information within the Group.

c) The duties of the Treasurer shall be to:

- supervise the financial affairs of the Group and
- keep proper accounts that show all monies received and paid out by the Group.

7) Finance.

- a) All monies received by or on behalf of the Group shall be applied to further the aim of the Group and for no other purpose.
- b) Any bank accounts opened for the Group shall be in the name of the Group.
- c) Cheques shall be signed by the Treasurer and one other nominated person of the Management Committee
- d) The Group shall ensure that its accounts are audited or independently examined every vear.
- e) The Group may pay reasonable out of pocket expenses including travel, childcare and meal costs to members or Management Committee members.

8) Annual General Meeting.

The Group shall hold an Annual General Meeting (A.G.M.) in the month of April. All members shall be given at least fourteen days notice of the A.G.M. and shall be entitled to attend and vote. The business of the A.G.M. shall include:

- i. Receiving a report from the Chairperson on the Group's activities over the year
- ii. Receiving a report from the Treasurer on the finances of the Group
- iii. Electing a new Management Committee and
- iv. Considering any other matter as may be decided.

At least 30% members must be present for the Annual General Meeting and any other General Meeting to take place.

9) Special General Meeting.

A Special General Meeting may be called by the Management Committee or ten members to discuss an urgent matter. The Secretary shall give all members fourteen days notice of any Special General Meeting together with notice of the business to be discussed.

10) Alterations to the Constitution.

Any changes to this Constitution must be agreed by at least two-thirds of those members present and voting at any General Meeting.

11) Dissolution.

In the event of folding of the club any assets remaining after all debts have been paid shall be given to another Group with a similar aim.

12) Adoption of the Constitution.

Until the first A.G.M. takes place the persons whose names, addresses and signatures appear at the bottom of this document shall act as the Management Committee referred to in this constitution.
